Your application will not be considered until a \$1,000.00 deposit is received by the Institute (All checks should be made payable to the University of Kentucky Student Leadership Abroad Institute). If you are not selected for participation, your \$1,000.00 deposit will be fully refunded. If you should decide to withdraw from the Institute after acceptance, your \$1,000.00 deposit will be fully refunded up to and including March 30, 2008. Beginning April 1, 2008, and up to and including May 31, 2008, you will receive a refund of \$100.00. After May 31, 2008, there will be no refund issued for any reason.

Conditions

Institute Participants are expected to attend and fully participate in all academic and co-curricular sessions of the Institute. While Institute Participants are on their own each evening, they are expected to attend all morning working sessions as well as adhere to the behavior and Code of Conduct of their respective institutions. The Institute Director, Dr. Patricia S. Terrell, may ask an Institute Participant to leave the Institute for any reason at any time during the Institute. This decision may not be appealed. Any Participant asked to leave the Institute will do so immediately and will not be allowed to continue to live in lodging provided by the Institute. In this event, no refund will be provided of any monies paid. Any Institute Participant who is asked to leave the Institute early gives permission for the Institute Director to notify the Participant's parent(s)/guardian(s). Each Participant will be responsible for his/her immediate travel home to the United States.

Institute Participants who plan to arrive early or stay over after the Institute must make their own arrangements.

While it is expected that all lodging, meals and programs will be offered per the printed brochure and web site, the Institute Director reserves the right to modify all services including but not limited to lodging, meals, transportation and program sessions as needed with every effort to provide comparability.
