## Tools

### **Any Video Converter (Freeware Video Clip Converter)**

Quick Tip:

First set your output folder so you can find the converted file

Click Add Video on top right

On the far right under Profile drop down menu, select Flash Video Movie (\*.flv)

Click Convert

Go to folder you set as Output Folder and retrieve the converted file

## Flash Paper (Document Converter)

Download available from within Connect Pro under “Home” on the menu bar, “Resources” tab, “Open” link in “Getting Started” box, item 3 under “Create Meetings.”

## Notes

### Mac User Note:

When sharing video using the iSight webcam, the Mac will show three different drivers to use. You must select the USB option when you right-click settings.

### White Board:

To ensure that everyone sees the tools for the white board, enable rights to share pod by clicking the gear and changing the setting.

### Audio Setup Wizard:

If you run the Audio Setup Wizard, Connect Pro will automatically select the correct mic to use during the session. It selects between the mic on the camera, any built-in mic, and a plugged in mic if present.

# Participant and Presenter Requirements:

Computer must have speakers and microphone (built-in or external). Headset with microphone recommended. Video camera optional, unless required by instructor.
