

**BCTC – UK Pathway to Transfer Sheet**  
**Associate of Arts for English**

Suggested Course Sequence for Smooth Transfer

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate of Arts degree at BCTC as well as the USP requirements for the University of Kentucky and the pre-major requirements for the Bachelor's degree in English.

English is a major in the College of Arts and Sciences, and therefore the requirements for the College of Arts and Sciences must be fulfilled to complete the Bachelor's degree. One of the A&S requirements is that students complete the fourth college semester of a single foreign language, or if the student had 2 years of a foreign language in high school, they could complete the third college semester of a second foreign language. The suggested curriculum would satisfy the College of Arts & Sciences foreign language requirement.

\*\* If the student had two years of the same foreign language in high school and chose to complete three semesters of a second foreign language for this curriculum, the student would not need to complete Foreign Language 202 and would instead choose another elective to complete the 60 credit hours needed for the Associate of Science degree. We would suggest selecting another 200-level history course.

\*\*\*This course is NOT required for the AA degree at BCTC. However, it is recommended that students continue taking English courses each semester, and this course would apply toward Bachelor degree requirements.
