# UKAEF MEMBERSHIP TRENDS AND FELLOWSHIP DONATIONS-SOURCE FOR CONCERN

By Susan Abbott-Jamieson and Jim Chapman The UKAEF Board has analyzed our membership trends and our Fellowship Fund contribution levels over the past few years. As of this date, we've enrolled 197 members. Based on previous years' membership levels, the Board had anticipated that we would have about 235 paid memberships by this date. This means that our revenues from membership fees are down about \$700 from last year. Donations to the UKAEF Fellowship Fund have also declined. Contributions for 2015/2016 as of this date are \$1060 less than those made in 2014/2015. We are not in financial trouble at this time because we had a \$3,500 operating expenses carry-over from 2014/2015 and a \$6,000 contingency fund for fellowships. If these trends continue, however, they will affect our future ability to continue to award three fellowships each year. because the decline in donations is occurring in a low interest environment for our fellowship endowment fund. This trend could also affect other aspects of our organization's operation. The Board will notify the membership of any future changes. In the meantime, if you know people who are eligible for membership but have not joined, encourage them to do so and become a part of our organization, and be sure to keep the UKAEF Fellowship Fund on your list of organizations to which you contribute. The students who receive our fellowships are both deserving and appreciative.

### FELLOWSHIP FUND CONTRIBUTORS

Thank you for contributing to the UKAEF Fellowship Fund that supports UK graduate students who plan to pursue university faculty positions (three awardees annually). Members' gifts totaled \$3,915.00 for 2015-16.
