Between 1989 and 1999, the representation of minority men among the full professor ranks increased by 3.5%, but the proportion of minority women at that rank declined by 3.2%.

Conversely, in the same period, the rate of increase of women of color at the Assoc. Professor rank was 4 times greater than that of men of color (+9.1% -vs.- 2.2%). At the rank of Asst. Professor, the proportion of men of color increased more rapidly than that of women of color (9.7% -vs.- 6.6%).
