Item #5: The original text of the petition indicated that the course title and number of SOC 451G would be changed but that the course description and purpose remained the same. This is true. However, the text failed to note that we are also changing the pre-requisites for the course. The former pre-requisites (6 hours of social science) were never enforced and, even if they were, they would not serve as an appropriate "gate-keeping" devise to ensure that the course is primarily reserved for Sociology majors. Our pre-major requirements are SOC 101 or RSO 102 AND 3 hours of Sociology at the 100-200 level. Since our current computing system does not allow us to enforce the second of our pre-major requirements, we have elected to enforce the more specific, first pre-major requirement.
