 A desire to make this course specific to production programs and provide opportunity to more faculty to teach this course. Currently it must be taught by members of the theory and history faculty. With the new change it can be taught by any member of the faculty as long the sub-title falls within the parameters of the title: American Theatre. This change also allows us to define American Theatre as not just the United States but, also in terms of the larger Americas. By creating a sub-title, a course may be offered that is related to current productions in the UK Theatre Season when appropriate.
