The following would be an addition to the Senate Rules in Section 5.3.2 (Undergraduate Colleges – Probation and Suspension Policies)

5.3.2.7 (proposed number) Gatton College of Business and Economics

Probation and Academic Suspension

In addition to the University rules on academic probation, suspension and reinstatement, the following rules apply to the Gatton College of Business and Economics.

- 1. No student with a cumulative UK GPA of less than 2.0 will be enrolled in the Gatton College of Business and Economics. Any student who fails to maintain a cumulative UK GPA of 2.0 will be dropped from the Gatton College of Business and Economics and will not be readmitted until this GPA is 2.0 or greater. No probationary notice will be given.
- 2. Any student enrolled in the Gatton College of Business and Economics who achieves a GPA of less than 2.0 in any semester will be placed on academic probation.
- 3. Any student on academic probation who fails to achieve a 2.0 semester GPA will be dropped from the Gatton College of Business and Economics and will not be readmitted until he or she has obtained a semester GPA of 2.0 or greater for one semester and the student's cumulative UK GPA is 2.0 or greater.
- 4. Students who are dropped twice from the Gatton College of Business and Economics will not be readmitted.

Rationale for Change:

The addition of this section on suspension and probation rules will bring the Gatton College in line with the rules of the College of Engineering. Essentially, this provides the student a one-semester suspension from the Gatton College only prior to suspension from the University thus permitting the student opportunity to pursue another major before being suspended from the University.
