	<u>Specification Writing</u> (3) This course provides an in-depth study of the importance of specifications in the design and construction process. Students will engage in research, evaluate the

quality of building materials, study the methods of writing specifications, and gain exposure to industry-standard software in preparing a variety of specifications. Prereq: ACH 150, ACH 160, ACH 161, or consent of instructor.
