## **Drop Course:**

AHP 841 Allied Health Practicum: The Context of Health Care Practice (3)

#### Change in Undergraduate Programs:

Drop the completion of AHP 841 as a graduation requirement for the B.H.S. in Health Services Management, Communication Disorders, and Clinical Laboratory Sciences.

# Rationale:

After thorough discussion by the Health Sciences College faculty and examination of all CHS undergraduate programs, faculty determined that each program provides significant interdisciplinary didactic and clinical experiences and that AHP 841 was redundant and, therefore, unnecessary. The proposed change will have no effect on accreditation requirements for any program and the number of hours required for graduation remains unchanged. Although most students acquire more than the 120 credit hours necessary for

graduation, they may take additional University Studies or elective courses if needed to meet the minimum credit hour requirement.

<u>Note:</u> The reason this action has been delayed is that it was discovered that this course drop and program change were pending when the Administration Building caught fire. The original file was recovered over in the Reynolds Building after an ACMC inquiry was made. The Undergraduate Council was consulted to ensure its acceptance and it is now ready to go forth to the Senate.
