At a recent meeting, the University Studies Committee approved the inclusion of the following courses in USP in the areas indicated in parentheses. The Senate Council concurs and recommends these to the Senate:

ARC 212	<u>History and Theory I</u> (Humanities)
ARC 213	<u>History and Theory II</u> (Humanities)

GLY 150 Earthquakes and Volcanoes (Natural Sciences)

<u>Background</u>: The USP Committee unanimously recommends that ARC 212 and 213 be added as options to satisfy the Humanities Disciplinary requirement and that GLY 150 be added as an option to satisfy the Natural Science Disciplinary requirement of the University Studies Program. The Committee considered course objectives as presented in course syllabi in conjunction with the goals of the USP Disciplinary Requirements in reaching its decisions. Each course provides the kind of experience that will enable students to appreciate disciplinary perspectives and methods as well as knowledge pertinent to the appropriate disciplinary area.
