New Course:

LIT 248 Library Services for Preschool Children (3)  
This course is a study of library services for preschool children, age infant to 5 years. Topics include library programming development and production, preschool children's literature, services for parents and for child care services, collection development, and legal issues. This is a web-based distance course that requires service learning activities. Prerequisite: LIT 115

EC 260 Practicum in Early Childhood Education (3)  
(Change in description and prerequisites)

Change to:

EC 260 Early Childhood Education (3)  
Students will, under supervision, develop practical skills in teaching children from birth through eight years of age. Emphasis will be placed on the preparation, implementation and evaluation of learning activities based on specific needs of children enrolled. Student and instructor observations and analysis of performance occurring in the program day will be included. Lecture, 3 hrs; Lab, .5 hrs.

Prerequisites: Completion of EC 120, EC 130, EC 170, EC 200, and FAM 255; and EC 220, FAM 252, FAM 256, or concurrent; or consent of program coordinator.
