Senator Mitch McConnell is fighting to support and protect Kentucky women.

For those who serve so faithfully, Mitch McConnell is working to ensure these brave women have the opportunities and support they need.

To help our military women, Mitch McConnell has voted to provide women with more opportunity in the armed forces by supporting legislation that would allow our military women more hands-on opportunities.¹

And he recently voted for legislation sponsored by Senator Kirsten Gillibrand that is aimed at protecting victims of sexual assault in the military.²

The Military Justice Improvement Act, S. 1752, would strengthen prosecution for sexual assault cases and bring those cases outside the chain of command.³ In early March, the Military Justice Improvement Act fell short in the Senate, but McConnell and others are still fighting.
