✓ To help our military women, Mitch McConnell has voted to provide women with more opportunity in the armed forces by supporting legislation that would allow our military women to fly combat missions.¹

✓ He also recently voted for legislation sponsored by Senator Kirsten Gillibrand that is aimed at protecting victims of sexual assault in the military.² The *Military Justice Improvement Act*, S. 1752, would strengthen prosecution for sexual assault cases and bring those cases outside the chain of command.³

In early March, the *Military Justice Improvement Act* fell just short in the Senate, but McConnell and others are still fighting.
