- ✓ He also recently voted for legislation sponsored by Senator Kirsten Gillibrand that is aimed at protecting victims of sexual assault in the military.<sup>2</sup> The *Military Justice Improvement Act*, S. 1752, would strengthen prosecution for sexual assault cases and bring those cases outside the chain of command.<sup>3</sup>

In early March, the *Military Justice Improvement Act* fell just short in the Senate, but McConnell and others are still fighting.
