

UK CAS: Look up Course Transfer Equivalencies

UK CAS is a web-based system which the state of Kentucky provides as a resource for transfer students.

UK CAS is also an option for advisors to look up Course Transfer Equivalencies. This short tutorial might be helpful.

UK CAS currently has the Course Transfer Equivalencies (CTEs) for **ALL Kentucky** schools (and **SOME "out-of-state"** schools). That is, not all "out-of-state" schools CTEs are in UK CAS, at this time, but we are working on it.

If you come across an "out of state" school which is missing from UK CAS (but you think has CTEs in IRIS Campus Management), just send Team APEX a quick email at APEX-WWW@lsv.uky.edu and we can add this school to UK CAS on a case-by-case basis.

- A) Go to: <http://www.uky.edu/degreeaudit/CAS/>. Click Login to **UK CAS** hyperlink (which leads to: <http://ky.transfer.org/cas/>). At UK CAS, click "**Guest Login**".

B) Click "**Course Equivalencies**", then **Browse by School**; then in Step 1, choose **Kentucky / University of Kentucky**; then in Step 2, choose **Region**, then **US States**, then **Kentucky** (or whatever state the transfer school is in), then click **Go** button and wait for list of schools to appear. Then Step 3, click checkbox for appropriate schools and click **Add Schools** button.

Then follow instructions below for **C)** and **D)**.
