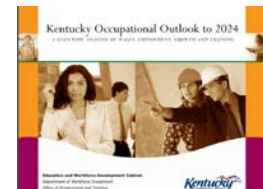

National Level Resources

Economic Development and Employer Planning System [Link](#)

An analytical tool that allows users to explore supply indicators (credentials conferred) and demand indicators (wage and employment projections) for programs of study and occupations.



Projections of Education Statistics (NCES) [Link](#)

A NCES annual publication that provides projections for enrollment and degree trends to 2024. Within this report, are national projections for Undergraduate and Postbaccalaureate enrollment and degrees conferred by important demographic variables.



Bureau of Labor Statistics (Occupational Employment Statistics) [Link](#)

OES data provides occupational profiles for over 800 occupations. Each profile provides national wage estimates, employment estimates, industry profiles, employment estimates by state/metropolitan area, and wages by state/metropolitan area.



Bureau of Labor Statistics (Occupational Outlook Handbook) [Link](#)

Publishes several reports analyzing job growth and employment projections to 2024 by occupation. Users may find it helpful to search by occupation group, but may also be interested in examining the published reports regarding fastest growing occupations expected to have the most new job growth.
