CONTINUING EDUCATION COUNCIL

The Continuing Education Council is appointed by the President to serve as an advisory and policy recommending body relating to University-wide continuing education matters. Representatives to the Council shall be from each sector of the University and Central Administration. Specifically, the Continuing Education Council shall:

1. advise the President on pertinent issues relating to continuing education.
2. recommend policy that will enhance the quality of the University of Kentucky credit and non-credit continuing education offerings.
3. where appropriate, develop and implement systems and strategies to meet Kentucky's continuing education needs effectively and efficiently.
4. facilitate compliance with Southern Association of Colleges and Schools accreditation requirements.
5. facilitate the provision of opportunities through continuing education offerings for cost-effective training and value-added interaction between participants in the programs.
6. maintain an updated roster of those responsible for coordinating continuing education in the University.
7. provide information to continuing education professionals in the University.
8. at least once a year, meet with continuing education professionals in the University to obtain their views and advice regarding continuing education.

An annual report of the work of the Committee shall be submitted to the President.
