NAMING OF UNIVERSITY BUILDING

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve the official naming of the building at 708 South Limestone, Lexington, KY as the “College of Medicine Learning Center.”

Background: The Committee on Naming University Buildings has reviewed the request and found it to be in compliance with university policy Administrative Regulation 9:5 and recommends approval of this name designation.

This request came to the Committee from the Provost and the College of Medicine Dean.

In 2004, the University acquired the Dermatology Associates building at 807 South Limestone (adjacent to the Bio-Pharm Bldg). The acquisition at that time, and records since, used the name “Mersack Leavell Building”, from the names of the prior owners. For well over five years, the College of Medicine has housed student learning and support programs there. Simulated exam rooms, study and lounge spaces, academic support offices, and a student computer lab are located there.
