REPAIR/UPGRADE/IMPROVE BUILDING SYSTEMS – <u>UK HEALTHCARE CAPITAL PROJECT</u> (GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL - REPLACE ELECTRIC SWITCHGEAR)

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the initiation of Repair/Upgrade/Improve Building Systems – UK HealthCare Capital Project (Good Samaritan Hospital - Replace Electric Switchgear).

<u>Background</u>: This capital project will replace a portion of the electric switchgear located in the Good Samaritan Hospital. The electric switchgear, original to the hospital building, controls the distribution of electricity throughout the facility. A portion of the switchgear is susceptible to failure and replacement is critical to ensure reliable electrical service for patient care and to meet regulatory requirements. This project also includes re-circuiting several crucial services to minimize downtime during the switchgear replacement.

This project has been authorized by the 2014 Session of the Kentucky General Assembly as part of a \$20,000,000 infrastructure pool for the UK HealthCare facilities. The project scope is \$1,500,000 and will be funded with agency funds.
