
## REPAIR/UPGRADE/IMPROVE BULDING SYSTEMS – <u>UK HEALTHCARE CAPITAL PROJECT</u> (PAVILION HA AIR HANDLING UNIT #9)

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the initiation of the Repair/Upgrade/Improve Building Systems – UK HealthCare Capital Project (Pavilion HA Air Handling Unit #9).

<u>Background</u>: This project will replace the air handling unit (AHU) #9 in Pavilion HA of the Chandler Hospital. This AHU is 26 years old and in poor mechanical condition. Replacement of the unit is necessary to ensure air quality, meet regulatory requirements and to maintain the interior environment without temperature fluctuation.

This project has been authorized by the 2014 Session of the Kentucky General Assembly as part of a \$20,000,000 infrastructure pool for UK HealthCare facilities. The project scope is \$2,000,000 and will be funded with agency funds.
