TERMINATION OF THE CENTER FOR HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE PRESERVATION

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the termination of the Center for Historic Architecture Preservation effective immediately.

<u>Background</u>: On December 12, 2000, the Board of Trustees approved the establishment of the Center for Historic Architecture Preservation. The Center aspired to be self-supporting through grants and contracts, but was unable to meet that objective. The Center has been without a director, staff, or new projects since August 2006.

The Center for Historic Architecture Preservation exists solely within the College of Design and has no affiliation with any other unit on campus. The recommendation to terminate the Center has the support of the Dean of the College of Design, the Vice President for Research, and the Provost.
