CHANGE IN NAME OF DEGREES

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the following degree changes in the College of Education, effective spring 2009 semester:

- 1. Change the name of the Bachelor of Arts in Education with a major in Kinesiology to Bachelor of Science in Education with a major in Kinesiology.
- 2. Change the name of the Bachelor of Arts in Education with a major in Health Promotion to Bachelor of Science in Education with a major in Health Promotion.

<u>Background</u>: The proposed degrees are based in the sciences and will give students a more competitive degree in their field. They are also more consistent with the university's benchmark institutions.

This proposal has the approval of the Undergraduate Council, Senate Council, and University Senate. The provost supports this recommendation.
