RENOVATE THIRD FLOOR LITTLE LIBRARY

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve initiation of the "Renovate Third Floor Little Library" capital project.

<u>Background</u>: This project will renovate and fit-up approximately 5,300 square feet of shelled space in the Little Library. Prior to the library consolidations following completion of the W.T. Young Library, this space was used to house library materials. The renovated space will house the Center for Applied Information Technology, a computer-oriented student area for the School of Library and Information Science, and three shared-use classrooms. The scope of the project is \$800,000, well within the legislative authorization of \$1 million and will be funded with unrestricted University fund balances.
