EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR LEGACY TRAIL (Maine Chance Farm/Spindletop Properties)

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees authorize the conveyance at no cost of permanent easements on Main Chance Farm/Spindletop Properties to the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government in order for the community to construct a bikeway trail/walking path from the Coldstream Research Campus north through the farm to Iron Works Pike commonly referred to as the Legacy Trail.

<u>Background</u>: The University of Kentucky and Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government have been coordinating the construction of a bikeway/walking path through the farm for the past several years. The city now has full construction funding in place and is ready to proceed. The Board of Trustees was previously presented information and approved of the trail, trail location, and the transfer of deeds with Vulcan Lands Inc. necessary to implement the trail at the Board of Trustees March 4, 2008 meeting. The action in this FCR will now allow for the specific authorization to execute the trail easements allowing the city to move forward with construction.
