CHANGE IN NAME OF AN EDUCATIONAL UNIT

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the change in the name of the College of Allied Health Professions to the College of Health Sciences.

<u>Background</u>: In the spring of 2001, a proposal to begin a discussion regarding a name change for the College of Allied Health Professions was submitted to the College of Allied Health Professions Faculty Council. The name change is appropriate and timely given that the words "allied" and "professions" no longer adequately describe the mission of the college. This change in name will broaden the scope of the college to include an increased focus on the scientific base, as well as the traditional "professions" part of the disciplines.

The proposal has been approved by the faculty in the College; recommended by the Senate Committee on Academic Organization and Structure and the Senate Council; and approved by the University Senate. The Provost of the University supports this recommendation.
