CHANGE IN NAME OF AN EDUCATIONAL UNIT

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the change in the name of the Department of Military Science to the Department of Military Science and Leadership in the College of Arts and Sciences.

<u>Background</u>: The commanding general of Cadet Command directed an extensive re-evaluation of subject matter taught within the Department. He directed a re-emphasis on leadership, counseling and mentoring skills, and a reduction of the traditional Common Task Training associated with basic soldier skills. The commanding general also directed the Department to undertake an extensive marketing and recruiting effort emphasizing the leadership aspect of the program. The name change best reflects the new direction set by the commanding general.

The proposal has been approved by the Arts and Sciences Faculty Council; reviewed and recommended by the Senate Committee on Academic Organization and Structure and the Senate Council; and approved by the University Senate. The Provost and the President of the University support this recommendation.
