REDESIGNATING UROLOGY RESEARCH FUND TO A PROFESSORSHIP

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve redesignating the UK Committee for Urologic Progress Endowment for Urologic Research in the College of Medicine to the UK Committee for Urologic Progress Professorship in Urology.

Background: The Board of Trustees accepted in June, 2001 gifts and pledges totaling \$80,000 from four members of the UK Committee for Urologic Progress to endow a urology research fund. The four donors are: Paul W. Chellgren of Villa Hills, Kentucky, and John R. Hall, James F. Hardymon and Harry "Mac" Zachem, all of Lexington, Kentucky. Mr. Hardymon, at the request of the college, and for and on behalf of the donors, desires to have the original gifts and pledges and the state's Research Challenge Trust Fund matching funds used to support an endowed research professorship in urology. Redesignation of the funds as a professorship will enable the division to recruit an outstanding physician scientist.
