NAME CHANGE FOR THE
DEVELOPMENT DIMENSIONS INTERNATIONAL PROFESSORSHIP
IN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH RESEARCH IN THE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve changing the name of the Development Dimensions International Professorship in Behavioral Sciences in the School of Public Health to the Development Dimensions International Professorship in Behavioral Health in the School of Public Health.

Background: The name change is requested to insure that no misunderstanding exists regarding use of the professorship for behavioral health research in the School of Public Health and not behavioral science research in the Department of Behavioral Science.

Development Dimensions International, a management consulting firm headquartered in Bridgeport, Pennsylvania, made a pledge of \$100,000 in October 2000 to establish a professorship that would support behavioral research in the School of Public Health. The pledge, matched by the state's Research Challenge Trust Fund, has been paid.
