## NAMING OF MEMORIAL HALL AUDITORIUM

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve naming the auditorium in Memorial Hall the "Edward T. (Ned) Breathitt Auditorium."

<u>Background</u>: Governor Edward T. (Ned) Breathitt did his undergraduate work at UK's College of Commerce and graduated from the College of Law in 1950. Throughout his career, which included service as Chair of the Board of Trustees, he was a strong advocate for the University of Kentucky and for higher education.

In recognition of Edward T. (Ned) Breathitt's many contributions to the Commonwealth, a proposal was submitted to name Room 0103 in Memorial Hall in honor of Governor Breathitt. The Breathitt family is supportive of this recommendation.
