CARDINAL HILL REHABILITATION HOSPITAL GIFT AND PLEDGE

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees accept a gift of \$10,000 and pledge of \$40,000 from Cardinal Hill Rehabilitation Hospital of Lexington, Kentucky to create and endow the Cardinal Hill Rehabilitation Hospital Fellowship in the College of Health Sciences and submit this pledge of \$50,000 for matching funds from Kentucky's Endowment Match Program. Council on Postsecondary Education guidelines require that the Board of Trustees acknowledge its responsibility for UK's participation in the program and for all university endowment funds.

<u>Background</u>: For many years, the College of Health Sciences has placed students at Cardinal Hill for clinical rotations and in turn, a large percentage of Cardinal Hill employees are graduates of the college. The college is entering a new partnership to build collaborations across the clinical, educational, and research missions. The fellowship will support collaboration of entry-level professional students in the rehabilitation disciplines of physical therapy and speech-language pathology.
