

Brief History

Alumni Career Services (ACS)

2002

With a small endowment from the Jane I. Morris Foundation, UK started one of the first ACS programs in the country. Caroline Francis was hired to be the first career counselor/program facilitator working six hours/week via UK STEPS.

2010

Career Counselor *Francis'* role was increased to a permanent UK 10-20 hours/week position. A full-time Career Counselor position was added. Programming activity included regional career counseling in Louisville and Cincinnati, Women in Transition Series, career assessment workshops, webinars, networking programs, and more.

2012

ACS hosted the Alumni Career Services Network national conference.

2013

The Central Kentucky Job Club began in partnership with UK Human Resources (HR) and UK College of Agriculture, Food and Environment Cooperative Extension Service.

2014


ACS launched "It's Never Too Late: Changing Career Direction After 50" workshop in partnership with UK HR.

2019

Francis' position was updated to Director of Alumni Career Services. Amanda Schagane joined as Associate Director.






