## <u>REPLACE UK HEALTHCARE IT SYSTEMS 1 (SINGLE ENTERPRISE</u> <u>ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD) CAPITAL PROJECT</u>

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees authorize the Executive Vice President for Health Affairs and Executive Vice President for Finance and Administration to execute an agreement to initiate and expend resources for the Replace UK HealthCare IT Systems I (Single Enterprise Electronic Health Record) Capital Project and make a Declaration of Official Intent to use UK HealthCare operations revenue to fund the project.

<u>Background</u>: This project will replace the current electronic health records system with a fully integrated patient centric electronic single enterprise platform to modernize UK HealthCare's (UKHC) digital infrastructure. UKHC's existing system does not meet the current needs of the enterprise nor is it sustainable to meet UKHC's strategic imperatives for the future. A new system is necessary to serve as the backbone for integrated information to support continuous improvement in patient care. The implementation period spans May, 2019 through June, 2021 which includes three months of pre-implementation planning, 21 months of implementation, and three months of post-live support.

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 8:2, any capital project with an estimated scope of \$1,000,000 or more must be approved by the Board prior to initiation. This \$280,000,000 project, authorized by the 2018 Kentucky General Assembly, will be funded with agency funds.
