An excellent job. Great patience. His willingness to consult outside of class and the amount of extra time he gave was amazing.


Dr. Derek Lane is an absolutely amazing professor. He is personable, intelligent and cares deeply for his students. I wouldn't want to take this class with anyone else!

Derek's primary strength is his dedication to his students' understanding of the material and genuine interest in classroom.






