## KGS Earth Analysis Research Library

**Earth Analysis Research Library, or EARL,** is the largest and most comprehensive public research repository of solid geological samples in Kentucky. These samples provide the best available information for ground-truth observation of Kentucky's subsurface. Examination and understanding of these materials can provide critical and cost-saving insights for energy exploration, environmental management, geotechnical investigation, hydrologic assessment, and geologic research.





## Overview of Collections (September 2019)

- A continuous record of the subsurface rock through a specified interval
- □ 16,609 Well sample sets from oil and gas wells
  - Fragments of rock produced during drilling
- 8,129 Limestone samples
  - Hand specimens and powdered samples
- 5,210 Coal samples
  - Coal quality and palynology samples from Center for Applied Energy Research and Kentucky Geological Survey
- □ 1,196 Soil/sediment auger samples
  - Selected samples from 1960–1978 U.S. Geological Survey-KGS mapping program in Jackson Purchase Region
