#### ABOUT THE SPEAKER/TOPIC

Dr. Christine Riordan became Provost of the University of Kentucky in July 2013. In this role, she oversees the academic integrity and operations of UK. In consultation with faculty, staff, students, alumni and trustees, Dr. Riordan is facilitating the development and implementation of UK's strategic plan and initiatives. She is also responsible for supporting and advancing academic programs, teaching and scholarship at UK.

From July 2008 through June 2013, Dr. Riordan served as dean of the Daniels College of Business at the University of Denver. In collaboration with the University, Dr. Riordan and her team built a fundraising system for the college and raised more than \$14 million/year in private and corporate funds. They increased the college's endowment more than 50% from \$70 million (2008) to more than \$110 million (2013) and also raised more than \$87 million in a campaign for the college. Under Dr. Riordan's leadership, Daniels was ranked among the top business schools in the world by several prominent publications.

Dr. Riordan has a national reputation as a leadership development and workplace diversity expert. Her research focuses on labor-force diversity issues, leadership development and effectiveness, and career success. Dr. Riordan consults regularly with corporations on strategic planning, leadership-development activities, diversity management and team performance.

Dr. Riordan lives in Lexington with her husband, two teenagers and an Olde English Bulldog named Georgia. She enjoys running, biking, lifting weights and she is an avid reader. She is a graduate of Georgia State University (Ph.D. and MBA)

Michele has been very active as a teaching assistant and primary instructor and was co-founder of the UK Critical Pedagogy Working Group. She is committed to a career in college teaching.

She is preparing for an academic career.

**Norman (Brad) Fox** has completed two years as a Ph.D. candidate in the Department of Mathematics. His research is in the field of discrete mathematics or, more specifically,

# GOOD NEWS REGARDING HEALTH CARE BENEFITS FOR 2014

All of you should have received a letter from Joey Payne, the Chief Benefits Officer at UK, regarding our health care benefits for 2014. However, I have mentioned this letter to several of my retired friends and they either did not get the letter or overlooked it. Therefore, I will provide an overview of the good news below:

- There is absolutely no change in our rates for the 2014 year. The switch to Anthem in July contributed significantly to this being possible.
- No action is required on your part to continue coverage in 2014.
- You will not receive a new Anthem ID Card so continue to use your current card.
- You will not receive a new Express Scripts ID Card so continue to use your current card.

The deductible for 2014 will be the same as the Medicare Part B deductible (as was the case in 2013). The 2014 Medicare Part B deductible is unchanged and will remain at \$147. There have been some transition issues in changing from Humana to Anthem. I know personally my wife and I had some billing problems. I contacted Carol Watson in the benefits office at 859-257-2124. She resolved my problem in less than an hour. If you experience any similar problems, contact Carol. She is there for our benefit and does an outstanding job.

Some of my friends have asked me recently if we (retirees on Medicare) have to do anything regarding the new Health Care Act (Obama Care). The answer is no, Obama Care does not apply to retirees on Medicare.
