Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for bachelor's degree in Social Work.

The College of Social Work is a selective admissions college. All new students enter as a pre-social work major. To be fully accepted, students must maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA as well as earn an A or B in SWK 124 and 222.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with the UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure both KCTCS and UK requirements are met.
