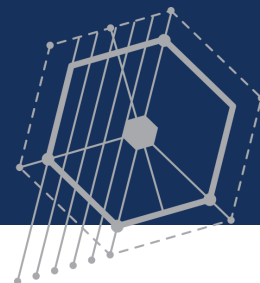

## Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Scholarships for Disadvantaged Students (SDS) in CSD

### Who is eligible?

If you are a graduate student and have sufficient documented unmet financial need and answered yes to one of the additional questions above, you may be eligible for funding that will **cover at least 50% of your college tuition**. Funding may be used to replace student loans for which you are eligible.
