## 087100S06 DOOR HARDWARE - Exit Devices

## 1.0 MANUFACTURERS

- A. Available Manufacturers: Subject to compliance with requirements, Manufacturers offering products that may be incorporated in the work include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - a. Von Duprin.
  - b. Precision.
- 2.0 All exit devices shall be of rim type construction.
- 3.0 All exit devices shall be operated by horizontal touch bar.
- 4.0 The touch bar assembly shall have a standard dogging feature.

## **Dogging Devices Not Permitted.**

Because swinging fire doors are required to positively latch, "dogging devices" are not permitted on fire exit hardware. A dogging device mechanically defeats the latching feature of panic hardware preventing the door from positively latching when in the closed position. The dogging device is typically manually activated with a small wrench or tool. A dogging feature is found only on standard panic hardware which should never be used on a fire door assembly.

- 5.0 Finish for the exit devices shall be US-26D
- 6.0 Exit devices for UL rated doors shall be rim type or vertical rod type.
- 7.0 Devices for labeled doors shall be listed with Underwriters Laboratories as fire exit hardware and shall have their label attached to the device.
