Legacy Tuition Program Application 2021-2022

DEADLINES: Fall Semester – March 1 Spring Semester – December 1

Through the Legacy Tuition Program, the University of Kentucky offers partial tuition awards to eligible non-resident undergraduate children of UK graduates. An eligible student is defined as a child whose mother, father, or step-parent has earned a bachelor, graduate, doctorate, or professional degree from the University of Kentucky, whose parent or step-parent is a life member (paid in full) of the UK Alumni Association, and who would normally be subject to non-resident tuition rates.

Please note completion of a medical or dental residency does not constitute a qualifying degree program. Also, parents that completed an associate's degree from a former UK Community College are not considered qualifying graduates.

Non-resident students approved for in-state tuition rates through the Academic Common Market (ACM) are not eligible to receive funding through the Legacy Tuition Program. For more information on ACM, please visit www.uky.edu/Registrar/acad_cmn_mkt.htm.

Unfortunately, the benefits of this program cannot be extended to grandchildren or other relatives of UK graduates.

Additionally, students awarded a tuition scholarship (such as the Singletary, Patterson, or Presidential Scholarships) or granted in-state residency through the undergraduate admission or residency application process are not eligible for this program. New first-time freshmen will be eligible for the Legacy Tuition Program for a total of eight semesters of undergraduate study. Transfer students are eligible through the equivalent of their eighth semester of undergraduate study. Semesters of prior college enrollment at other institutions are considered in the total eight semesters.

Automatic renewal each semester is contingent upon the student's full-time enrollment on the UK main campus while maintaining a good academic standing and the qualifying parent's life membership (paid in full) in the UK Alumni Association. Eligibility for continued enrollment in the program will be verified each semester.

Students are required to complete the Legacy application in order to receive the benefits. **Awards are offered pending early application and availability of funds.**

Applicants for the Legacy Tuition Program are required to submit the following to the Office of Academic Scholarships no later than March 1 for fall enrollment or December 1 for spring enrollment:

- Completed Legacy Tuition Program Application (this form) bearing the student's and qualifying parent's signatures and date of application.
- Copy of Birth Certificate or Adoption Records of Student (listing student and qualifying parent).
- In case of step-parent, copy of marriage license.
- IN ADDITION**, all applicants (incoming freshmen and transfer) must have applied for admission and have a qualifying test score and high school transcript with qualifying unweighted GPA on file with the Office of Undergraduate Admission by the Legacy Tuition Program deadline, March 1 for fall applicants or December 1 for spring applicants. Awards are offered pending early application and availability of funds.
- Qualifying parent's life membership (paid in full) in the UK Alumni Association.
