



UK Institutional Research Brief:

Selected Results of the University of Virginia's Survey of Required Tuition and Fees: 2006-07 to 2007-08

Fall 2007

The University of Kentucky participates annually in the University of Virginia's Survey of Tuition and Required Fees. In fall 2007, 45 public and 35 private doctoral research universities completed this year's survey. Table 1 shows the tuition and fees associated with UK's undergraduate, graduate and first-professional programs for 2006-07 and 2007-08, accompanied by the percentage change in these charges. Presented below are highlights from this year's survey comparing UK to participating public universities.

Highlights of 2007-08 Tuition and Fees Charged

Undergraduate-Level Programs (45 public universities reporting)

UK ranked . . .

- 26th in resident and 42nd in out-of-state tuition and fees charged.
- 9th and 15th in its percentage increases in resident and out-of-state charges, respectively, from last year.

Graduate-Level Programs (45 public universities reporting)

UK ranked . . .

- 27th in resident and 35th in out-of-state tuition and fees charged.
- 9th and 7th in its percentage increases in resident and out-of-state charges, respectively, from last year.

MBA programs (42 public universities reporting)

UK ranked . . .

- 31st in resident and 32nd in out-of-state tuition and fees charged.
- 10th and 8th in its percentage increases in resident and out-of-state charges, respectively, from last year.

Law Schools (30 public universities reporting)

UK ranked . . .

- 21st in resident and 25th in out-of-state tuition and fees charged.
- 16th and 13th in its percentage increases in resident and out-of-state charges, respectively, from last year.

Medical Schools (25 public universities reporting)

UK ranked . . .

- 11th in resident and 4th in out-of-state tuition and fees charged.
- 2nd and 3rd in its percentage increases in resident and out-of-state charges, respectively, from last year.
