

- Is MS able to estimate and then make recommendations about what kind of minimum internet speed (if that's even the correct item) is needed to take advantage of these upcoming new features like stitch, crowd reactions, live transcription, etc?
 - There are many complexities with live meetings. Bandwidth is one issue as well as contention for wireless connections and lack of computing resources, specifically memory constraints, on an individual's computer. There have even been issues based on what software is installed on a given computer. Typically, the video and audio compression is very good with Teams. Most of the issues regarding video and audio issues are related to the individual computer/network access and not the Teams hosting environment.
- Can I talk to a person privately in a breakout room? Also, is it recorded?
 - The meeting organizer can record a Breakout Room. To record a Breakout Room, the organizer must be in the room to start the recording. The organizer can leave the room and the recording will continue.
- How do we improve the video quality of our meetings?
 - There is some more end user control coming so that users can control their video quality based on their internet speed and connection
