Kentucky State University (KSU), in partnership with the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday Planning Committee, is excited to offer the annual MLK Student Scholarship. The scholarship is open to high school seniors who plan to attend KSU. Scholarship recipients will receive one-year of paid tuition to KSU beginning the Fall 2022 semester. Eligibility: Students must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 and a minimum ACT score of 18. Recipients will be chosen based on their essay in addition to extracurricular and community activities they are involved in that demonstrate a commitment to civil and human rights. Academic excellence and achievement will also be considered throughout the selection process.

Application Requirements:

For consideration for the scholarship, students must submit:

- A completed application form
- A resume and/or list of extracurricular and community activities
- A 350-500 word count essay on either of the following topics:
 - If MLK were alive today, what would he say about the state of our country during this global pandemic?
 - How have HBCU's been disproportionately affected during this global pandemic?
- A completed KSU application
