UK College of Nursing, Assistant Dean, Equity, Outreach and Social Justice: My primary role is in helping to support efforts to achieve successful academic outcomes, social justice efforts that enhance faculty, staff and student engagement with diverse populations and enhance community outcomes.

Major Accomplishments Include: Service by appointment as Chair of the UK College of Nursing Dean's Health Equity and Racial Justice Task Force where I solicited insight from senior leadership diversity council, diversity ambassadors group (staff/faculty and students) and the Council (faculty /staff) to develop a planning document for next steps toward racial justice and equity in the College of Nursing. I serve as a key partner on the UKHealthcare diversity, equity and inclusion council and as well on this council community outreach subcommittee where I support the development and implementation of an equitable COVID-19 vaccine role out into BILPOC communities and build partnerships with the community faith leaders toward health education and equitable access to services. I have developed a doctoral cognate course that looks at critical issues at the praxis of theory, knowledge and action toward health justice. It examines social factors that underlay the root causes of health disparities through a lens that embraces social and structural justice and equitable health solutions.

UK Strategic Advisor, Community Engagement and Academic Partnerships Office of the Provost: My primary responsibilities are to identify opportunities for the University to expand its footprint in the community through inward and outward best practice outreach approaches.

Major Accomplishments Include: Through this position I have embarked on a listening tour meeting with over 50 stakeholders on campus and in the community, identified strengths and opportunities where the institution can advance and strengthen its partnerships with the community to redress and impact equities and disparities, Chaired the Provosts' Explore to Build Commission on Equity and Engagement, created and submitted university wide explore-to-build conceptual plan to create the 'Just Institute' as an institutional starting point, advised and counselled senior administrators equity and social and racial justice, envisioned and co-lead the community outreach arm of the University Institutional Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Strategy, served by appointment of the Provost on the University COVID Return to School Planning Group and on the University COVID Community Partners Planning Group, serve by community appointment on the Bluegrass Community Foundation Black Prosperity Fund to create and oversee an endowed fund for racial equity and anti-racist work, and also as the Community Engagement Lead for the UK UNiTe (United in True Equity) RPA. Additionally I have an appointment on the UK Economic Development Collaborative as Lead of the Equitable Economic Development Core.

UVA Academic Director, Community Engagement and Partnerships: My primary responsibilities were to provide innovative leadership, strategic vision and oversight of critical community and university partnerships relevant to the academic enterprise, the School of Nursing and priority communities.

Major accomplishments include: Through this position I created 8 new clinical academic partnerships, 14 research partnerships, and sustained numerous agency partnerships, co-founded the UVA Equity Center, re-established a Nurse-led neighborhood clinic with a very at-risk, vulnerable neighborhood, implemented of undergraduate community IPV simulation for hundreds of students, lead more than 500 students and faculty to engage with legislators at the annual Cancer Prevention Day Workshop in Washington DC.
