

Deans' Interprofessional Honors Colloquium

Spring 2022 topic explores the impact of interprofessional care on those with cognitive and/or physical disabilities.

This Interprofessional (IP) one (1) credit hour course will provide health professions students with an interactive seminar-based forum to explore the characteristics & implications of interprofessional practice. Methods of instruction will include limited didactic presentations with significant interactive small group learning. IP small groups will complete a project to be presented to leadership in their colleges at the conclusion of the course.
