

## Objectives

The following objectives have been developed within the limits of the philosophy that suggests that student personnel work should be an integral part of the educative process.

1. A major objective of the Office of Student Services is to continue to serve the College of Nursing students and faculty in the areas of admissions, recruitment, student records, counseling, orientation, graduation, academic advisement, co-curricular activities, student data projects and evaluation, and other general guidance services.
2. A major objective of the Office of Student Services is to work collaboratively with the associate deans and dean of the College of Nursing and faculty toward meeting the needs of students.
3. A major objective of the Office of Student Services is to maintain appropriate lines of communication supported by well-developed and workable methods of reporting with the dean of the College of Nursing.
