

Licensure Disclosure Basics

U.S. Department of Education regulations and the NC-SARA agreement requires the University of Kentucky to disclose whether or not its licensure programs meet the educational requirements to pursue licensure in a student's state. UK Distance Learning assists programs in researching this information, drafting disclosures, and maintaining the licensure dashboard where prospective and current students can find licensure information for their state and program.

Disclosure Requirements

What programs are impacted?

All Licensure Programs

"An Education program that is designed to meet the educational requirements for a specific professional licensure or certification that is required for employment in an occupation, or is advertised as meeting such requirements."

Both Online and
Face-to-Face Programs



Institutions must disclose whether...



a program **MEETS** the educational requirements for licensure in a state.



a program **DOES NOT** the educational requirements for licensure in a state.



a institution has **NOT DETERMINED** whether it meets the educational requirements for licensure in a state.

How Does UK Research This Information?

- In the fall of each year, UK Distance Learning reaches out to programs to see if there are any significant program changes or new out-of-state activities.
- UK Distance Learning reviews state authorization and licensure information for programs. UK Distance Learning drafts licensure disclosure statements.
- Programs will receive updated information in February and be required to confirm the information by end of April.

Where Can Students Find Licensure Information?

- Licensure information can be found on the [TLAI Licensure Dashboard](#).
- Licensure program websites are required to have a statement with a link to this dashboard so that prospective students can easily find this information.
- At the beginning of the spring and fall terms, UK Distance Learning sends an email to all students in licensure programs reminding them where to find this licensure information.
