FY 2020-21 BUDGET REVISIONS

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees authorize and approve the following revisions to the FY 2020-21 budget. The budget revisions outlined below will increase the University of Kentucky's current funds budget by \$373,858,500 – from \$4,429,389,500 to \$4,803,248,000.
