#### **Enrollment representativeness**

- Record enrollment of URM undergraduate students (16.9%)
- Record enrollment of URM graduate students (13.4%)

#### Success of BIPOC or disadvantaged students

- Number of bachelor's degrees awarded to Black/African American students increased from 196 in 2011-12 to 355 in 2019-20
- Percentage of Black/African American graduate students increased from 4.6% in 2015-2016 to 6.8%\* in 2020-21
- Percentage of Hispanic/Latino graduate students increased from 2.4% in 2015-2016 to 4.4%\* in 2020-21
- Based on CPE data, the UK increased the number of Bachelor's degrees to low income students from 1,350 in 2014-15 to 1,501 in 2018-19, an increase of 11.2%. In the same period, degrees to low income students at all other Kentucky institutions declined by 5.2%

#### Faculty hiring and retention initiatives

- College of Education "Dynamic Dozen"
- Office for Faculty Advancement collaborating with Office for Institutional Diversity on initiatives to improve recruiting and retaining minority faculty
- Increase in resources for hiring minority faculty (from \$2.25 million to \$2.75 million in FY2021) through collaboration with the Provost, Vice President for Research and Interim Vice President for Institutional Diversity

### **Healthy Kentucky Research Building**

- Phase I: Floors 2-3 completed (Diabetes/Obesity, Cancer, HEAL, Health Equity Center, Informatics, Rural and Population Health)
- Phase II: 4th and 5th floors are close to opening (Cancer)
- Phase III: 1st floor construction is underway from an NIH supported C06 construction grant (Cardiovascular, Alzheimer's disease)
- Phase IV: 6th floor in the design phase using UKRF funds to complete the \$265M research building
