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## **PROVOST REPORT**



New academic program proposals must address many requirements, including the following:

- Program objectives
- Intended student learning outcomes
- Target audience
- Evidence of employer demand or discipline needs
- Employment prospects for program graduates



According to EAB (2019), "between 2025 and 2029, the number of college-going students will decline by 15% -- that's over 400,000 fewer students in a span of four years. What's more, the profiles of our students are changing."

We must address student needs for long-term, lifelong learning, including a focus on adult, nontraditional students, especially focusing on career advancement.

#### A Turn Toward Stable Careers

Growth in fields related to government and nonprofit jobs, but will these remain stable in current crisis?

#### No Boost for Big Fields

Education, MBA growth slowed. Almost no recession impact on health, non-MBA business.

#### Slowdown in STEM?

Engineering, computer science fast-growing overall but grew more slowly during 2008 recession
